







## Which LPs are most committed to private equity?

The Global Investor 100 includes a "ranking within a ranking", highlighting exposure to the asset class not only by dollar amount but by percentage of investment portfolio. Some at the bottom of the list are arguably more "committed" than those at the top




## Most entrants are based in North America

While the US has the greatest number of institutions listed in the Global Investor 100, those based in Canada have the highest average allocation to private equity on a US-dollar basis


#### Number of investors by country or region of origin






## Spotlight on: Public pension funds


#### Number of public pensions by country or region of origin





The asset managers and investment firms are geographically diverse, with institutions from the US, Canada, Asia-Pacific, Europe and the UK








## **Spotlight on: Insurers**

The insurers in the Global Investor 100 have, on average, \$5.5bn invested in private equity, just over 5% of their overall portfolios











## Spotlight on: Foundations and endowments

The foundations and endowments on the list have by far the highest average allocation to private equity by percentage of their overall portfolio, at 24.6%













# Spotlight on: Sovereign wealth funds and government-related investment organisations

Institutions in this category have the highest average allocation to private equity on a US-dollar basis, at \$17.8bn













Spotlight on: Private pension funds, corporate pension funds and banks






## Who are the most active fund investors?


